# Report on Dumfries First International Street Food Festival

## The Event







On Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2022 MOOL put on the Dumfries's first International Street Food Festival in Dock Park Dumfries. The aim to show people how much we benefit from people from different places coming to the area and attempt to shift people's views from regarding the welcoming of displaced people from being a matter simply of kindness to a recognition of the enormous benefits which come from a diverse society.





We were looking for all kinds of Street Food stalls for the festival and a part of the stated intention of the proposal was to involve a wide range of community groups from different cultures to run stalls.

We didn't just want this to be about food. We also hoped it would be a chance to share other aspects of culture. We were hoping to have people who can share particular cultures' music, stories, etc.







The event started nominally at 10:00 but the park really started to fill up after 12:00. We had aimed to get 15 different stalls taking part and had estimated around 600 people would attend. The event actually had 21 stalls of which 13 were community groups (6 concerned with food). The group taken on to ensure security, DGRU, estimated the numbers attending to be around 4000.

The event was extremely popular with genuinely enthusiastic responses from the public and from the stall holders.



### What went well?

The work done by Strawberry Lemonade Events to publicise the event was excellent. The numbers attending attest to a really good reach of publicity particularly in view of the other events available on the day.

All the stall holders were excellent in coming in with an attitude of welcome and community spirit.

To the people attending the event seemed well-run and properly organised. See note below on group requirements.

The event produced a variety of food which many of the people attended had not had the chance to try before.

All the stall holders achieved excellent sales and many, if not all, sold out by the end of the day.

## What could we improve?

Strawberry Lemonade events were faced with stall holders who, because of the unusual makeup of the proposal, were not as clear about their requirements and needs as they could have been and there were several enterprises who, having earlier committed to coming in had to back out for various reasons. Coping with the confusion and getting everything working required a lot of on-the-spot adaptations which were nonetheless executed very successfully.

Owing to this being the first time we had run the event I underestimated the likely take-up from the public. While this meant that all stall-holders achieved more sales than they expected it also meant that food ran out and people were left wanting more towards the end of the event.

We were unable to get as many groups involved in the entertainment as we would have liked and, although those that did come were wonderful it would have been good to have a bigger variety and more options.

We were not as clear about the starting time of the event as we could have been resulting in staggered arrivals of stall holders (though some got lost trying to find us) and a slow arrival by the public. We might want to open later in the morning although the success of this first event and the lack of National Jubilee competition (and even the fact that the food ran out somewhat) might make people come in earlier.

We should consider additional Health and Safety precautions particularly if more groups will be using open flames.

If the numbers grow, then we might need a person to do some stewarding around the parking. There were definitely issues around traffic and parking on the day although these may have been exacerbated by other events in the town at the same time. We may need to do a TTRO- which is a meeting with the council and Police Scotland around traffic and get a company to put some cones out (signed off) to prevent rogue parking.

We might seek to get in a better sound system.

We would need to give more thought to waste disposal during the day. We need to think about more waste bins in particular food recycling and a budget for bins to be maintained throughout the day as overspill was challenging.

More entertainment both for adults and for children (possibly including a bouncy castle and similar items.
